

### 1. General Information for International Residents

### **Living Information for International Residents**

#### Resident Registration (Jumin-toroku)

A resident card (zairyu-card) is issued at the airport when entering Japan. All international residents are required to register residency within 14 days of finding a place to settle down. To do so, visit a municipal office of your residence with your resident card. Once you file the registration, you can request a copy of residence certificate (Jumin-hyo). All residents are required to report change of address when moving in to Hachioji from another city, ward, town or village, moving within the city and moving out of the city. Visit the Civic Affairs Section (City Office 1F) or the 14 branch offices to make the report. Please note that some offices have different opening hours.

\*The resident registration requirements do not apply to temporary visitors and short-term visa (3 months or less) holders.

### **Disaster Preparation**

#### **Designated Emergency Evacuation Site**

Evacuation sites are designated separately for cases of earthquake and severe weather. For details and lists of of the evacuation sites, please scan the matrix barcode to visit the city's website.

#### Designated Emergency Evacuation Site (Wide-Area Evacuation Site)

A Wide-Area Evacuation Site is a safe place to be during an emergency event, such as an earth quake induced fire and a toxic gas leak. Large parks, university campuses and other outdoor open areas are designated.

#### Designated Emergency Evacuation Site (Temporary Evacuation Site)

#### ■ Earthquake

A Temporary Evacuation Site is where you should go first when an earthquake or other disasters strike. It serves as a information center as well as a community relief activity base. Outdoor schoolyards of municipal elementary schools and junior high schools and metropolitan high schools are designated.

#### ■ Severe Weather

These Temporary Evacuation Sites are set up when an evacuation order, etc. is issued. Indoor gymnasiums of municipal elementary and junior high schools and community centers are designated.

#### Designated Evacuation Shelter (Evacuation Shelter)

An Evacuation Shelter is a indoor space where evacuees who have lost their homes can live temporarily in the event of a large-scale disaster. Gymnasiums of municipal elementary and junior high schools and community centers are designated.

#### **Temporary Accommodation**

A temporary accommodation is a place for people to stay when public transportations are suspended.

### Pack an Emergency Kit

A readily packed emergency kit will help you to evacuate without delay. Prepare essentials that you and your family may need at an evacuation shelter. Make sure to include warm clothings during winter.

#### Primary Items: Items to take with you to a shelter

**Valuables** 

Cash (include 10 yen coins for payphone use), passbooks, legal documents, driver's license, seal, Ids, etc.

Portable Radio

AM/FM transistor Spare batteries

Flashlight

With spare batteries

Emergency food

Hardtack, canned food, bottled water, etc.

First aid medicine

Include medicine for chronic medical conditions

Other items

Underwear, tissues, plastic wraps, feminine hygiene products, phone charger, mask, etc.

## Secondary Items: Items that support you for at least three days without infrastructures

Food

Rice (processed/instant), snacks, etc.

**Fuels** 

Tabletop stove, portable stove, solid fuel, etc.

### Drinking water

3 liters per person per day

#### Other items

Domestic water, blankets, emergency toilet kits, toiletry items, a soup pot, plastic sheets, buckets, etc.

#### Pet necessities

Pet food, a cage, toiletry kits, a collar and a leash, etc.

#### Tax

#### Municipal and Metropolitan Inhabitant Tax (Resident Tax)

All official residents as of January 1 of the year are liable to pay Municipal and Metropolitan Inhabitant Tax. Please report your annual financial statement of the previous year regardless of the income amount. You will be asked to provide your My Number and a legal ID when filing a the report.

\*if you are qualified for dependent/spouse/disabled/spouse special tax deduction due to your family member who lives abroad, you will be required to provide a document proving the relationship and the money transfer.

No need to make a report if:

- -You filed an income tax return (kakutei-shinkoku).
- -Your only income source was salary earnings and the figures have been reported to the city by your employer.
- -Your only income source was from public pension and the figures have been reported to the city by the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare.

If you fail to file the report, your request for Municipal and Metropolitan Inhabitant (Resident) Taxation Certificate, which is necessary when you apply for child allowance, daycare, public housing and visa renewal, will be withheld. Reporting period is from February 1 to March 15 (except for weekends and national holidays) every year. Please contact the Resident Tax Section when leaving your job and leaving Japan for good.



#### **National Pension**

#### Joining the National Pension System

The National Pension is a public pension system which provides supports for retirement, disabilities due to accident, householder's death and more. All registered residents aged 20 to 59 years are required to join the system.

#### **Premium Exemptions**

#### ■ Legal Exemption

Persons who are on basic disability pension or public assistance (excluding international residents) are eligible.

#### ■ Exemption/Payment Postponement

Lower income households may be qualified to be full or partial exempt from the premium payments.

Postponement may be granted for those who are under 50 years old.

#### ■ Special Exemption for Students

Students who are studying at eligible schools and have income lower than the income cap are eligible.

#### ■ Lump-Sum Withdrawal Payment

International residents who have made payment for national or social pension for more than a set period of time and left Japan with losing the qualification of Japanese pension may claim the Lump-Sum Withdrawal Payment up to 2 years after losing Japanese residency.

#### ■ International Social Security Agreement

International Social Security Agreement has been concluded to eliminate dual social security taxation and to avoid wasting paid contribution payments. Under the agreement a period of enrollment in Japanese pension is regarded as that of a country that concludes the agreement with Japan to fill a gap for one's coverage (aggregation of coverage periods).

#### **National Health Insurance**

#### Joining the National Health Insurance System

#### ■ Eligibility

National Health Insurance (NHI) system serves to reduce policyholders' medical expenses in case of an illness or injury. It is operated by tax paid by policyholders and subsidies from national and metropolitan government. All residents are required to be enrolled in NHI except: Policyholders are provided with an insurance card.

- •Those who are on public assistance
- Foreign nationals staying Japan for less than 3 months or with short-term visas

#### Pregnancy Report/ Maternal and Child Health Handbook

When your doctor approves your pregnancy, please submit pregnancy report to Health & Welfare Centers, the Civic Affairs Section of the City Office 1F or branch offices. The Maternal and Child Health Handbook will be issued to you. Pregnancy consultation service is available at the Health & Welfare Centers and a small gift package called "Hachi \*Baby

Gift" will be given to all who received a consultation.

Fourteen prenatal checkup tickets, one prenatal cervical cancer screening ticket, four ultrasound test tickets, one newborn hearing screening ticket and two postnatal health checkup tickets will be issued when you submit the report. With those tickets, you can receive subsidies on your checkups, screening, and test fees. The detailed amounts of those subsidies are indicated on each ticket. For those with a multiple-pregnancy will be provided with two additional ultrasound test tickets (total of six tickets) at the pregnancy consultation. Maternal and Child Health Handbook is available in 10 languages (English, Spanish, Portuguese, Chinese, Korean, Thai, Tagalog, Indonesian, Vietnamese and Nepali).

#### Vaccination for Children

The city sends vaccination reminders to parents and guardians of applicable children. The reminders are mailed out in the month when a child turns two months old for Rotavirus, Hepatitis B, Haemophilus influenza type B, Pediatric pneumococcal, the 4-in-1 (diphtheria/tetanus/pertussis/polio), Tuberculosis (BCG). Reminders are mailed in the applicable year's birth month for MR first term, Varicella, Mumps first term, Japanese encephalitis first and second term and the 2-in-1 (diphtheria/ tetanus) second term and in April of the applicable year for MR second term and Mumps second term. For Human Papillomavirus vaccine, a reminder is sent to girls in grade 6 and 10 in April. Please read each reminder through, make an appointment with a designated medical institution and have your child vaccinated for all vaccines included in the municipal vaccination program. ### **Long-term Care Insurance**

All the residents aged 40 years and over are liable to pay the insurance premium. When a policyholder is qualified for care, 70, 80 or 90% of the expense is covered by the insurance.

#### **Insurance Certificate (Insurance Card)**

For persons aged 65 years and over (the first degree insured) an insurance card is issued on 65th birthday or on a day when a person becomes newly qualified due to moving in to the city. #### Pet

#### When Bringing a New Dog Home

When you bring a new dog home, register the dog (once in a lifetime) within 30 days, vaccinate it against rabies yearly and have it wear dog tag and rabies vaccination certificate.

Please note that a dog tag will not be issued for dogs that have been implanted with a microchip and whose information have been registered with an agency designated by the Minister of the Environment. Make sure to update the owner's information on the registration certificate received from a pet store or breeder and receive a new certificate.

#### \*Dog Microchips

Currently, all dogs sold at pet stores are microchipped. The microchip contains a 15-digit individual identification number, and the law requires owners to update information of the dog and of its owner with a registration agency designated by the Minister of the Environment. The city doesn't require those microchipped dogs to wear a dog tag.

#### For Dog Owners

#### [Rabies Vaccination]

All dog owners must vaccinate their dogs against rabies yearly during April and June and receive rabies vaccination certificate. Vaccines are available at veterinary clinics and group administration venues.

#### [Dog Tag and Rabies Vaccination Certificate]

Dog owners must have their unmicrochipped dogs wear a dog tag and rabies vaccination certificate. If you lose a dog tag or rabies vaccination certificate, request a replacement. The obligation is waived for those microchipped dogs with the required information registered with a Ministry of the Environment designated agency.

#### [Report a Change in Registered Information]

Please report any updates on owner's name or address, or when a dog dies to the city. For microchipped registered dogs, report updates and death to a Ministry of the Environment designated agency instead of reporting them to the city.
